Nominations may not be submitted by or for employees or the family members of employees of the Embassies organising the Prix.

All applications must be received by 31 January 2015.

ART. 2: JURY COMPOSITION

The Jury will be made up of the Ambassadors organising la Fête de la Francophonie in Sweden.

ART. 3: PRIZE

The winning project will receive the Prix 2015 de la Francophonie en Suèdeø

The Winner of the Prize will receive a sum of SEK 30,000. All applicable taxes are to be borne and paid by the Prize recipient.

The Winner will be personally informed in March 2015 the latest.

The organizers reserve the right to cancel the Prize if circumstances make it necessary.

ART. 4: GENERAL CONDITIONS

By entering the nomination process, all parties agree that the organisers and their partners have the right - within the context of the Prix - to distribute information about the nominated projects without providing any form of financial or other compensation to the participants.

In case of interrogation over the interpretation of this document, the original French version will be definitive.

ART. 5: AGREEMENT ON THE RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

By entering the nomination process, all parties fully and unconditionally agree to accept the rules as outlined in this document and agree to accept the decisions of the Jury, which are final.
